Background:

Endangered Species are threatened species of plants, animals, and fungus whose population levels are dropping, putting them at risk of **extinction**. Once a species is extinct, there are *none left in the world*.

of Nature's Red List (IUCN) of Threatened Species has evolved to become *the world's most comprehensive* information source on the global extinction risk status of animal, fungus and plant species.
