


NATURAL EXPLORERS

COVID-19 Safety

LIMITED CAMP SIZES

Our camps will be capped at a smaller capacity than previous years to allow for proper social distancing.

MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED

All campers are required to wear a mask or face covering that covers both the nose and mouth for the duration of the session. Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks as well.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Each camp will be housed in its own dedicated space at Central United Methodist Church or UNC Asheville to allow for social distancing and to limit contact with those outside of the camp.

HAND WASHING + HAND SANITIZER

There will be a hand sanitizing station in each classroom. Campers will also be required to wash their hands throughout the day.

CLEANING PRACTICES

The museum, classroom spaces, and materials are frequently sanitized throughout the day by staff and volunteers.

Safety protocols may be subject to change in response to public health guidelines and best practices.
